School Information

- kindergarten to Grade 8 dual-track school located in Caledon scheduled to open in September, 2012
- located on Learmont Avenue in the Strawberry Fields housing development north of Mayfield Road and east of Kennedy Road
- projected enrolment will be approximately 370 students: 160 in Kindergarten to Grade 8 and about 200 students in grades 1 to 3 French Immersion (will be temporarily housing some gr. 1 to 3 FI students from the Fletcher's Meadows area of Brampton)

What a Facility!

- will be ready by March Break
- first school in Peel to use geo-thermal energy
21 degrees celsius all year (even in June!)
- wireless network/Internet access throughout
- beautiful Library, Science Lab, Art Room and a Design/Tech room

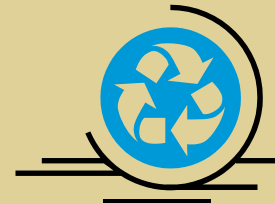
Teaching With Technology
